Christmas goodies: how to choose the better of two evils

Will it be ham or turkey? Candy cane or truffle? Dietitian Gloria Tsang explains healthier choices

Which is better? Vancouver registered dietitian Gloria Tsang examines some favourite Christmas treats.

Ham or Turkey: Skip the turkey skin and you've got a low-fat meat with lots of nutrients. Ham generally contains 15 times more sodium than the same amount of turkey and also contains nitrates, a controversial ingredient linked in some studies to cancer.

Soft cheese or hard cheese: If you're counting calories, choose soft cheese, but if you're after calcium, eat the hard.

Gingerbread cookies or chocolate-dipped shortbread: Gingerbread cookies usually contain half the calories, sugar and fat found in chocolate-dipped shortbread.

Candy cane or truffle ball: The candy cane is 100 per cent sugar, has 55 calories and lasts forever. The dentist won't like it. The truffle ball contains about 85 calories and will contain some antioxidants if it's made with good dark

chocolate.

Red wine or white wine: Red grapes are loaded with antioxidants shown to increase good cholesterol and prevent blood clotting. White wine doesn't contain beneficial antioxidants.

Wine or beer: A 12-ounce can of beer has 150 calories. A five-ounce glass of wine contains 140 calories. In comparison, a glass of juice has 150 calories and a can or regular pop has 160 calories.
